Now I ask you to join my wife and I in making a donation to the "Send a Nurse to Haiti Campaign" whose ambitious humanitarian effort is to send volunteer nurses to Haiti promptly. The "Send a Nurse Campaign" is sponsored by the California and U.S. Nurses Association.

Within hours after the disaster struck, the Registered Nurse Response Network began recruiting registered nurses eager to volunteer to provide life-saving emergency medical care to victims.

10,000 registered nurses have signed up to travel to Haiti. The RN Response Network has experience with recruiting and deploying nurse volunteers to disaster areas, including the South Asian tsunami, Hurricane Katrina and the fires in the Los Angeles area. Nurses recruited by RN Relief Network stayed for months after the tsunami.

The RN Response Network needs your help now to cover the cost of travel and shelter for these nurses. Please help to turn this remarkable outpouring of volunteers into action on the ground in Haiti.
