Regarding: Neighborhood Request County Funds For the Installation of

a POD Camera at Folsom Blvd and Julliard Dr/Florin Perkins Rd

It has been observed that there have been an increasing number of individuals loitering around Folsom Boulevard between Howe Ave. and Watt Avenue. The intersection at Folsom Blvd and Julliard Drive/Florin-Perkins Road adjacent to the Kiefer Probation Center is one of the major problem areas.

The College-Glen Neighborhood Association is currently working with the area business and community to deal with the increasing security issues in the shopping center including working with the Sacramento City Police Department to secure Police Observation Devices (POD) cameras at the major entrances/exits to the neighborhood.

The City has offered to cover half of the \$12,000 cost per camera or \$6,000 with the community paying the other half. The County Probation & Neighborhood Alternative Centers are located in the Kiefer Center and service the entire County of Sacramento's reentry population. This translates to the processing and release of all inmates within the County of Sacramento in our neighborhood. In that the community views this county service as part of the problem, we are asking that the County of Sacramento to fund the community half of the cost for the POD camera at the intersections of Folsom Blvd and Florin-Perkins Road/Julliard Drive.
