Dear College Greens & Glenbrook Neighbors,

Re: Investment in the Security of our Community

Sacramento Police Chief Sam Somers Jr. has offered to partner with the CGNA in the installation of Police Observation Devices (PODs) in our neighborhood as part of a “crime prevention pilot project”. The cost of each POD Camera including parts, assembly and installation is \$12,000. Chief Somers has offered to install and maintain 5 cameras about the perimeter of our neighborhoods if our community will fund half of the initial cost of \$ 6,000 per camera or \$ 30,000 for our share.

The CGNA Board has formed a 501(C) (3) non-profit foundation to facilitate this joint project. The Board is hopeful that enough households and businesses will join us in investing in this opportunity to bring the latest high tech crime-fighting tool to our community and make our community a safer place to live and work. On the back of this letter is a copy of a memo from the Police Captain for our area regarding the benefits of the POD cameras.

Because the CGNA Foundation is a 501(C) (3) non-profit corporation all donations to the **CGNA Foundation POD Fund** will be 100% tax deductible on Schedule A of your Federal Income Tax. The CGNA Foundation’s first effort to secure funds through the CGNA News has brought in enough funds for two of the five cameras. We are hopeful that by contacting area businesses, and mailing to each of the households in our community that have not previously contributed to the fund, we will be able to raise the additional \$18,000 needed to fund the remaining three cameras.

The Board thanks you in advance for your support of this community project.
